All information (maps, documents, agreements, correspondence etc.) held in relation to:

- (a) the City of Edinburgh Council's ownership of land included within the boundaries of Bonaly Country Park.
- (b) any lease arrangements for land within the boundaries of Bonaly Country Park and owned by the Council.

The park appears to be composed of 5 properties, labelled 1 through 5 on the attached map.

- 1. At 412 acres this parcel forms the bulk of the park and is considered Common Good.
- 2. This area of land was acquired for the construction of Bonaly Reservoir. This is a statutory function, and therefore the land is not considered Common Good. It falls under the Culture and Leisure account, although its intended use is not necessarily for public recreational use.
- 3. This area is part of the park, but because it was acquired later it is not considered Common Good. This property also falls under the Culture and Leisure account.
- 4. This area of ground was recently (2019) acquired from MacTaggart and Mickel, we presume this has been subsumed into the park area. This falls under the Culture and Leisure account.
- 5. This is Torduff Reservoir, a statutory function so not considered Common Good. It's intended use is not necessarily for public recreation, although the road on north of reservoir is used by the public for accessing the park.
