Good Afternoon Jacqui

Due to us not being able to identify whether any caravan being removed has seized axles or collapsed wheel bearings we are only able to lift them rather than use any other method.

To complete these uplifts, we obviously must use a crane or truck mounted crane to provide us a hook above the caravan and we then proceed to pass a sling underneath the caravan and up either side to attach to the hook. Obviously as caravans are meant to be towed and not lifted, the body structure isn't designed for load bearing meaning that all caravans will be damaged to some extent as the slings pull tight during the procedure. The amount of damage depends on many variables but ultimately there will be damage made to all caravans.
