

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984: SECTION 14

**The City of Edinburgh Council hereby give notice under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, that for the reason set out in Section 14(1)(b) of that Act and to facilitate:**

Improved bus journey times, to ensure that services remain responsive to public health measures and reliable during the current Covid-19 pandemic, being undertaken by The City of Edinburgh Council the following restrictions, as per the Schedule apply.

1. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
  - a. "Article" means an Article of this Order;
  - b. "bus lane" has the same meaning as in Section 44(4) of the Transport (Scotland) Act 2001;
  - c. "parking attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
  - d. "pedal cycle" shall have the meaning assigned to that phrase by section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;
  - e. "public service vehicle" shall have the meaning assigned to that phrase by section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981, and, for the purposes of this Order, applies where the said vehicle or vehicles are being operated as a Local Service, as defined in the said Act;
  - f. "road" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) act 1984 and, for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this order, includes part of a road; and
  - g. "taxi" shall have the meaning given to that word by section 23 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982.
2. For the purposes of this Order, a vehicle shall be deemed to have entered, or to be proceeding in a bus lane in the Schedule to this Order if, during the hours described in Article 3, any part of said bus lane is below any vehicle or its load.
3. Save as provided in Article 5, no person shall, between the hours of 07:30 to 09:30 and 16:00 to 18:30 hours on Monday to Friday inclusive, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a bus lane described in Schedule, provided that nothing in this Article shall apply to any vehicle entering or proceeding in a bus lane where the person in control of the vehicle is required by law to do so or is obliged to enter or proceed in a bus lane in order to avoid an accident, a parked vehicle or is prevented by circumstances outwith his control from avoiding entering or proceeding other than in the bus lane and as soon as possible causes the vehicle to leave the bus lane.
4. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order, no person shall, except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto

or unload from any vehicle on any part of the roads and hours described in the Schedule to this Order.

5. Nothing in:
  - a. Article 3 and 4 of this order shall apply to vehicles being used in the service of the Police, Ambulance or Fire Service; and
  - b. Article 3 of this Order shall apply to public service vehicles, taxis or pedal cycles.
6. Whilst this Order continues in force, The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018 shall be suspended in so far as any of the roads described in the Schedule to this Order are effected.

SCHEDULE – list of roads where Waiting, Loading & Unloading are prohibited & Temporary Bus Lanes are in operation

Captain's Road	Bus Lane at Certain Times, 7:30 - 9:30 & 16:00 - 18:30	Captain's Road (south side) from a point 66 metres or thereby, west of the extended west kerblines of Southhouse Broadway, westwards for a distance of 196 metres	24/07/2021	9 Days
Captain's Road	Waiting at all times	Captain's Road (north side) from the west kerblines of Gracemount Road, westwards for a distance of 56 metres	24/07/2021	9 Days
Captain's Road	Waiting at all times	Captain's Road (north side) from the east kerblines of Gracemount Road, eastwards for a distance of 54 metres	24/07/2021	9 Days
Captain's Road	Waiting at all times	Captain's Road (north side) from a point 74 metres or thereby, east of the extended east kerblines of Gracemount Road, eastwards for a distance of 111 metres	24/07/2021	9 Days
