In 2019 ARUP undertook a study, commissioned by SESTrans on the A701 Sustainable Corridor. In this study it refers to three options being considered by the council for walking and cycling improvements to the Straiton Junction.

Could you supply more information on the proposals such as drawings or feasibility study please?

Initial feasibility work was undertaken in 2018 to develop possible options for redesigning Straiton Junction to increase safety for all users, with specific attention given to pedestrians and cyclists.

However, as part of this feasibility work, it was established that Midlothian Council were developing plans for a major reconfiguration of the whole junction beneath the A720 Edinburgh City Bypass and it was therefore decided not to proceed with any further work at that time.
