Can you please provide a figure of how much it cost you to draw up the bid, as part of the competitive bidding process?

If you submitted more than one bid, can you please provide a cost for each bid.

We have calculated the amount of hours involved in developing and managing the UK CRF bids for Edinburgh was 70.5 hours.

Total Cost (including employer on-cost) - £1,982.27

For the calculation per bid - we received 11 bids following our call for applications. We submitted 6 of those that we felt met the criteria to UK Government. From the 6 submitted we had 1 application that was successful.

The calculation per bid for the 6 submitted bids is £330.38.

In addition to this, three other people were involved in the assessment and moderation of the 11 bids we received for the funding. Approximate time for each panel member was 21 hours. As these people are not employed by the Council, we do not hold their salary costs.

We are unable to provide a further breakdown as there is no information recorded as to which bid the officers were working on at specific times.
