# Bullying incident data extracted from the central Bullying and Equalities Module (2019/20 and 2020/21)

The incident count used is the <u>highest possible count of incidents</u>: it includes each instance of the perceived reason being displayed, per pupil and per nature of incident. For example, if one pupil experienced racism by 2 other pupils and this involved both name-calling and abusive messages, this would show as 4 instances of racism. In the previous system (up to June 2019) this would have counted as only one incident.

#### NOTE 2

## Data for 2019/20 and 2020/21

There has been a marked increase in the total number of recorded incidents from 2019-20 to session 2020-21. The total number of incidents for session 2019-20 is significantly lower than would be expected. This is explained by the lack of familiarity with the new recording system (2019/20 was the first year of implementation in Edinburgh) and also by the period of school closures from mid-March to end June 2020. We put in place steps to address this in session 2020-21 including: implementing a strengthened 'Preventing and Responding to Bullying and Prejudice' procedure; supplementary guidance on tackling racist incidents; and training for school Equality Co-ordinators. We continue to monitor data and support schools.
