How many individuals have applied for the Self-Isolation Support Grant of £500?

12,354 applications received from the start of the scheme on 12<sup>th</sup> October 2020 to 30<sup>th</sup> November 2021.

How many of those applications were made by self-employed people?

How many of applications made by self-employed people automatically received the payment due to being on existing benefit schemes such as Universal Credit, Pension Credit, Working Tax Credits, income-related Employment and Support Allowance, income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, Income Support, and Housing Benefit?

How many self-employed people who were not on benefits received the Self-Isolation Support Grant of £500?

How many applications for the Self-Isolation Support Grant of £500 made by self-employed people were rejected and what were the top three reasons for rejection in these circumstances.

What was the total expenditure on Self-Isolation Support Grant of £500 made for self-employed people?

Unfortunately, we will not be able to provide the data you have requested as the cost to the Council of locating, retrieving and providing you with the information exceeds the statutory maximum of £600.

The information cannot be generated by a report and therefore the information would need to be manually extracted.

During the period in question, 1<sup>st</sup> October 2020 to 30<sup>th</sup> November 2021, we received a total of 12,354 applications. It is assessed that the extraction and collation of the data would take 6 minutes per application.

Therefore, the total manual hours required would be 1,235.4.
