The number of people who died awaiting the start of an initial package of social care in 2021.

This information is not recorded. This question implies a causality between being on a waiting list itself and people dying. Individuals seeking social care assistance are among the most frail and vulnerable in our society and so there is a higher risk of mortality than the wider population at any point of their time involved with us.

The maximum number of days an individual has been waiting for the commencement of an initial social care package according to your current records of those waiting.

As at 11 February, the longest wait is 925 days which is significantly higher than the current average due to the extremely specialised provision of care and accommodation need required in this specific case.

As at 11 February, there are 852 people waiting for a package of care.
