

36001 Dean Park Crescent

How often has the carriageway of Dean Park Crescent been inspected, repaired over the last five years?

There has been a total of 69 inspections on Dean Park Crescent in the last five years (23/02/2017 to 23/02/2022). These include 'ad-hoc', 'Mobile' and 'Safety inspections' covering the carriageway and the footway. We cannot provide separate data only in relation to the carriageway as the inspections covered both the carriageway and the footway.

There were two 'ad-hoc' repairs carried out on the carriageway at Dean Park Crescent in this period.

How much money has been spent on repairing damaged roads in Edinburgh over the last 5 years?

We do not monitor the specific amount spent on pothole repairs. We have a revenue surfacing maintenance budget which includes an allowance for fixing potholes but also covers other surfacing works such as footpath repairs. This budget was introduced in 2020/21 and the spend is summarised below:

2020/21 - £1,380,733

2021/22 – £1,348,685 up to the end of February 2022

Previous to this, there was no dedicated surfacing budget, simply a revenue maintenance budget which covered a much larger scope than carriageway repairs.
