What checks are made on school drivers?

Operators are required to demonstrate they hold a Passenger Vehicle Licence to comply with DVLA standards.

2Drivers are required to demonstrate they hold a current PVG Certificate with photo I.D. Drivers cannot operate unless they are issued with a CEC Pass. The CEC pass is only issued when an up-to-date PVG Certificate is scrutinised by the Travel Team along with photo I.D. The Travel Team ensure that the CEC issue Pass matches the vehicle that the driver should be driving (a note of registration is retained).

Insurance is required and a pre requisite of being offered a contract with CEC.

CEC Drivers are required to undertake a DVLA licence check and PVG Certificate must be provided as part of the recruitment process.
