One x 3000-gallon tank sunk in 1967 and one x 3000-gallon tank sunk in 1977.

Tanks were used until 2000.

We hold a letter from Continental Tyres which suggests their intention to decommission the tanks from 10 Jan 2000 in accordance with HSE guidance. No further information is held regarding de-commissioning.

Are there any known leaks or spills associated with the tanks?

Are there any records of integrity testing? If so when was this undertaken and what were the results?

There is no relevant information held.

Please provide any additional information on the site e.g. in relation to petroleum storage, diesel storage or any other substances, where available.
