Gravel has recently been placed on the path near the wall nearest the forth in Lauriston Castle by the firm P1. In addition wheel chair paths were created next to the steps again along the same path.

specific specifications given/presented to P1

It is not possible to provide details of the specification for this location. However, the specification for footpath works in the grounds of Lauriston Castle was as follows:

- Fill existing voids in footpath with type 1 sub-base & whin dust compact to levels.
- Import and spread 20t of whinstone (to match colour on-site) to fill voids in existing paths as directed by the Council;
- Construct 2nr ramps using timber edge, type 1 sub-base and whin dust surfacing (12m2 in total)

dates between which the work was carried out

The contractor was on site between 7 and 21 February 2022.

quality assurance post work carried out

The work was inspected following completion by a Parks and Greenspace Officer.

cost of work carried out separating between the cost of materials, labour and other costs

It is not possible to provide an accurate breakdown of the cost; however, an approximate breakdown is as follows: 20% labour, 10% plant, and 70% materials. The cost of the complete works was £3,925.
