
## 36838 Cameron Toll Site

We are just looking at a site at the southwestern boundary of Cameron Toll in the south of Edinburgh (adjacent to the west of the Sainsbury's petrol station). We know that the site formed part of the grounds of Liberton Bank (house) until the construction of Cameron Toll and obviously there is the Braid Burn approximately 15m east of the site and the petrol station adjacent to the site.



Does the Council hold specific records associated with the site?

Any further information regarding the site would be greatly appreciated.

As has been stated, the land of interest is located directly to the west of the petrol filling station associated with Cameron Toll shopping centre. The Braid Burn runs in culvert some 15m to the east of the land of interest which was previously associated with Liberton Bank House. No further information is held which relates specifically to the site of interest highlighted in the plan provided with your request.
