Can you please provide the following details from the records which you hold under The Licensing Act 2003:

In Scotland the relevant legislation is the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, and not The Licensing Act 2003 as stated in the request. The information is provided in terms of the 2005 Act and associated regulations most notably The Licensing Register (Scotland) Regulations 2007.

The act provides for a summary that includes name of the premises, the address of the premises, name of the licence holder, name of the premises manager which is provided in the attached spreadsheet. The Council has a paper register where copies of the application, operating plan, layout plan, applications to vary the licence and outcome of any review of the premises by the board.

We can arrange for the documents for any particular premises to be viewed. The regulations do not provide for information on the address of the individual who is the premises manager, nor do we require premises to specify a category and therefore that information is not held.
