What has been used to cull wild plants around the perimeter of Lochend Park? And also at Leith Links.

The only area in Lochend Park that has been treated is an annual wild-flower meadow. This was treated with Glyphosate.

No chemical has been used within Leith Links, nor has any area been cut that had not been cut in previous years.

Please confirm the chemicals used. If there is a reason why these chemicals were used, please include this information.

As above, the chemical treatment was Glyphosate and has only been used within the area of the annual meadow. This is required to reduce the more aggressive weed species before the annual wild-flower mix is re-sown.
