Private providers in partnership with the local authority receive a funded hourly rate from the council to enable their business to meet the requirements of the Funding Follows the Child, National Standard for funded early learning and childcare. This supports business sustainability and enables private providers to meet the cost of delivering funded ELC including paying the real living wage and ensuring their staff have obtained the bench mark qualification for their role, or if they are still within their first 5 years of registering with the SSSC have started to work towards this.

Documentation detailing CEC's policies, direction, or decision making basis for allocation of this funding including confirmation of any legal, Care Inspectorate, SSSC or other governing body registration requirements for eligibility.

Private providers are responsible for the training and qualifications of their own staff, however, in addition to the hourly rate, the local authority provides them with additional funding to enable their registered managers to obtain either a BA Childhood Practice or PDA Childhood Practice Level 9.
