In a follow-up to 36345:

It has been stated that 'the decision to carry out the survey on the Victorian Glasshouse was taken by officers of the Council.'

Which part/department of the council were they working for and what prompted them to instigate the survey?

The survey was carried out by the Council's Asset Management Team. They run a five-year cycle of condition surveys, i.e., each property has to be surveyed at least once every five years and this survey formed part of this schedule.

The only 'correspondence' we hold is the attached survey report. This is a record of the surveys which have taken place. The team responsible have confirmed that they record all of the information in respect of surveys in their system, therefore there is no other relevant correspondence or information recorded.

Redactions have been applied where the information is not within scope of the request, i.e., where it does not relate to the glasshouse.

It has been stated 'external sources of funding are currently being identified.'

What are these and when were these instigated?
