Number of accidents/incidents involving cyclists on the Tram Tracks at Haymarket.

The Council currently has vetted personal injury collision data up to the end of January 2022. We only hold details of personal injury collisions supplied by Police Scotland and no data is available to us on collisions that do not involve personal injury or incidents described as “near misses”; as these types of incident do not have to be reported to the Police (or to anyone else), there is no way of collecting comprehensive data. In addition, what constitutes a near miss is open to interpretation and any data would therefore be subjective.

Tram operations began on 31 May 2014.

Haymarket has been taken as a point where the tram joins the road network at Haymarket Yards, westwards along Haymarket Terrace and Clifton Terrace to a point at the junction with West Maitland Street.

Within that timescale and the boundaries given above, there were 3 personal injury collisions involving cyclists on the Tram Tracks at Haymarket.
