Please could the council provide details of any incidents in the last three years (May 2019 to May 2022) where a decision was made to physically intervene with a pupil/pupils within a school.

For each incident, please provide the following details;

- date of intervention
- name of school
- age of child involved (or an age range, ie 5-10,10-15, if data protection is an issue)
- reason for intervention
- how the intervention was made and how the child was controlled (ie, restrained, isolated in a room, etc)

This information is not held centrally and there is no requirement to report these incidents on our Health and Safety system.

The information might be held a school level on an individual pupil record. There are over 51,000 pupils registered each year for Secondary and Primary schools and it is estimated that at just one minute per pupil record it would take around 850 hours to locate and collate the information for one year.

Therefore, unfortunately, we are unable to provide you with the information you have requested as the cost to the Council of locating, retrieving and providing you with the information exceeds the statutory maximum of £600.
