

### 37900 response

Request for information relating to the inspections and jetting out of storm and foul drainage runs close to the Premises. Please provide information on complaints of subsidence or compression of the bus lane on St John's Road.

The storm and foul drains outside 221B St Johns Road are managed and maintained by Scottish Water, not the City of Edinburgh Council.

We have a road gully situated nearby 221 and the bus stop. The extract below shows the routine maintenance of this and is as follows:
