## **Amendments to the Contract**

Costs associated for the above change were not part of the submission of contract as these costs were to be negated by City of Edinburgh Council facilitating the processing directly through their own PSP provider.

NSL were asked if this could be provided until such time City of Edinburgh Council are able to take over the processing of all payments.
