As above, information is not available to allow the businesses to be identified.

Please can you detail any changes to environmental health /or food enforcement activities your organisation has implemented in response to Natasha's Law?

The City of Edinburgh Council has moved to Food Law Rating Scheme interventions since inspections restarted in October 2021, this requires a food safety and food standards inspection to be completed at each inspection where food labelling laws would be discussed.

How many breaches of allergen labelling compliance have you been notified of from within your Local Authority area since October 2021?

There have been 22 alleged breaches reported to Environmental Health.
