There is no specific funding for Civil Defence for Scottish local authorities; The Civil Defence (Grant) Act 2002 applies to England and Wales only.

The majority of the Council's funding comes from the Scottish Government and whilst the need to spend on Civil Protection does form part of the overall calculation, in common with all elements of the formula for distributing Grant Aided Expenditure, it is not ring-fenced.
