				Weaknesses / Recommendations: However, there was some dumped clothing, litter, graffiti unsightly bins and encroaching vegetation that wasn't particularly welcoming. Other entrances were unfortunately worse.

				Weaknesses / Recommendations: Some entrances are unannounced and requires improved maintenance regards litter, GM and graffiti. No path from NE corner to facilities. Not a busy access road but no crossing point from Niddrie Marshall Road entrance and where pavementends. Bollards and barriers preventing unauthorised access but access obtained from other points. A bit of vehicle movement on site by contractors,

Weaknesses / Recommendations: Lots of arisings on main grass area. Poor maintenance outside of bulk grass cutting. Encroaching vegetation and weeds around entrances and obstacles.
