

## 55376 Communal Bin Review (Phase 6) Trial: Impact on Neighbouring Areas

The City of Edinburgh Council has run the Communal Bin Review (Phase 6) trial, consulting residents in the trial area but not those in neighbouring streets, despite their direct impact from changes in waste management. No published impact statement, evaluation criteria, or feedback of the trial's effects on neighbouring areas is available.

### Impact on Neighbouring Areas
