Other than in the case of the Housing Revenue Account, we combine all of the Council's funding sources (primarily Government Grant, Business Rates, Council Tax and income from fees and charges) in supporting service provision. While there are elements of the council's grant funding that are ringfenced for specific purposes, the majority of funding received is a block grant and this is allocated across services as part of the annual budget setting process.
