Request for a list of all bridges currently closed or restricted in the local authority area, including

- The date they closed or became restricted
- If known, the estimated cost of bringing them back into use
- If known, the estimated timescales for bringing them back into use

We attach a list of all bridges within the City of Edinburgh Council area that are currently restricted. The restrictions listed are as follows:

- Closed – Structure closed to vehicular traffic (road bridges) or closed to pedestrians (foot bridges).
- Weight – Assessed capacity less the 40T ALL in accordance with DMRB document *CS454 – Assessment of highway bridges and structures*.
- Height – Clearance height under bridge less than 5.03m.
- Narrowing – Carriageway width restricted.

The information on structures within the local authority area has been included for all bridges as requested. However, information provided for structures not owned by the City of Edinburgh Council has been provided by the structure owners and may not have been verified or complete.

In addition, the pedestrian bridge at Katesmill across the Water of Leith within Colinton Dell remains open, but access is slightly restricted. The Council has commissioned a repair and expect it to be completed in the next 8 weeks. Estimate cost is £30k.
