Violent incidents can include verbal abuse or threats including face to face; online and via telephone; physical attacks; threatening behaviour; racial abuse and sexual harassment/violence.

We are unable to provide the breakdown of the centrally recorded Health and Safety data into female and male staff as the cost to the Council of locating, retrieving and providing this information far exceeds the statutory maximum of £600.

Section 12(1) of the Act does not oblige a Scottish public authority to comply with a request for information if the authority estimates that the cost of complying with the request would exceed the statutory limit.
