56980 Edinburgh Training Centre Ltd - Investigation Report

I understand that there was a potential food poisoning incident at the Edinburgh Training Centre Ltd. events venue in March 2024 which resulted in around 20 people developing symptoms consistent with food poisoning, and two people were hospitalised.

I wanted to confirm whether an investigation is on-going.

If not, what was the result of the investigation? (i.e. was the cause of the symptoms food-borne or viral?)

I also understand there was correspondence in June 2025 between Clyde & Co solicitors and Edinburgh Council regarding the incident at the Edinburgh Training Centre in 2024. I am reaching out to confirm whether some kind of legal action has been filed regarding the incident.

The information held by Environmental Health has been released in fulfilment of the Freedom of Information request 55476, however, I can confirm that the outcome of the investigation was that it was likely viral. An inspection was carried out as part of the investigation and advice was given about deep cleaning the premises to stop any further spread. No evidence was gathered in relation to any confirmed cases of food poisoning; the investigation is complete and there is no legal case on-going in relation to Environmental Health.
