Request for the following information for permanent signs with directions.

The annual spending on wayfinding signage (including maintenance, replacement, and installation) for each of the last three financial years.

Across the City of Edinburgh, the Council's Traffic Signs Team and the Transport Contracts and Design team, spent the following on the maintenance, replacement and installation of Direction Signs:

2022/23 = £18,300

2023/24 = £7,970

2024/25 = £8,502

The number of wayfinding signs replaced in the city centre in each of the last three financial years.

In the City Centre Ward of the City of Edinburgh, the Council's Traffic Signs Team replaced the following number of Direction Signs:

2022/23 = 1 sign

2023/24 = 3 signs

2024/25 = 3 signs

The average repair time for damaged wayfinding signs (measured from report to completion of repair) over the same period.

From the time of reporting to the time of repair completion, the average repair time for damaged Direction Signs that were managed by the Council's Traffic Signs Team across the City of Edinburgh was:

2022/23 = 95 days

2023/24 = 56 days

2024/25 = 40 days
