Councillors approved the recommendations in the report, with some amendments. Officers are now working to reflect this decision in the Council's social media guidance for schools and other services.

In line with the report, officers will recommend that if schools have an established presence and wish to remain on X, that they use it for essential updates only while prioritising other channels for day-to-day communications.
