Completion of these courses is not recorded accurately enough to be able to provide the number completed, and completion rate (%).

In regard to mandatory training, I can advise the following:

## **Child Protection:**

All school based staff complete Specific Workforce (previously known as Level 2) training. All school staff engage in the Annual August Child Protection Refresher. From August 2025 the frequency of this has changed to every 2 years (from 3).

Those staff who have, or may have, responsibility for leading Child Protection in an education setting complete Intensive Workforce (previously known as Level 4) training. From August 2025 the frequency of this has now changed to every 2 years (from 3).

All staff in leadership roles must complete Managing Allegations of Abuse against staff and volunteers and Tackling Domestic Abuse as a Workplace Issue. These are to be completed annually.

There is an additional expectation that Child Protection Coordinators complete the Home Office Prevent Duty Awareness training.

## ASL/ASN

The ASD training is mandatory. It is however delivered in a three year cycle, so from 2020-21 to 2022-23 all mainstream schools received the Autism mandatory training. The 2023-24 – 2025-26 cycle will again be complete for all mainstream primary and secondary schools.

It is not possible to determine how many PSAs have completed this training as these staff are not always contracted beyond their hours of contact with pupils. This has been addressed in the past via larger training events at the start of school sessions where all PSAs have been invited to attend.

## Training specification:

- Module titles and the currency/renewal period (e.g., every 2 years).
