What is the maximum pedestrian waiting-time at crossings in your Council area?

The standard maximum vehicle green time at standalone pedestrian crossings in Edinburgh is 20 seconds, followed by the safety period prior to the green signal appearing.

There are some standalone crossings where the vehicle green signal time is higher if the crossing is linked to a nearby junction, typically up to 100m between the crossing and junction, or if the crossing forms part of a public transport priority route.

Where this is the case, the maximum vehicle green signal time can be up to 40 seconds.
