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State the dates on which it has carried out an inspection of the wooden footbridge which passes over the Water of Leith between St. Mark's Path and St Mark's Park in Edinburgh since 1st January of 2020.

A formal engineering inspection was undertaken on 06/07/2022.

The bridge is visually assessed by parks staff during site visits, and any concerns reported. Ad-hoc inspections were undertaken on 15/11/2022 and 14/10/2025.

Provide details of the defects identified on each inspection since 1st January 2020

See attached records held by the Council detailing the inspection findings of the General Inspection. The ad-hoc inspections did not identify any new defects, but email correspondence noted the same tearing damage to the top chord of the bridge, and rotation of this chord.

During a routine assessment (November 2024) a loose tread on the bridge was identified and was remediated immediately.

Provide details of any remedial works which it has ordered as a result of any inspection since 1st January 2020 together with dates on which any such works were completed and, the costs of any such works which were defrayed by the City Council.
