

58572 Road Adoption Request: Land at Haugh Farm, NEWBRIDGE, EH28 8LA

Please note that a [list of public roads](#) is available to view and download from the Council's website.

I note that the road leading from New Bridge to the A89 has been marked as a carriageway. Please note that in the images below, the road appears to have been blocked off at both ends. I would be grateful if you could confirm the position.

Under the Traffic Regulation Order "The City of Edinburgh Council (Bridge Street, Newbridge, Edinburgh)(Prohibition of Vehicles) Traffic Regulation Order 1997 – TO/E/97/80" the section of Bridge Street, Newbridge as described below was closed to vehicular traffic. This order came into effect on 03/02/98.

Bridge Street, Newbridge, Edinburgh – From its junction with the A89 south-eastwards to a point 20 metres or thereby north-west of the northwest boundary fence of No.3 Bridge Street.

This section of road remains adopted but is no longer open to vehicular traffic. Only pedestrians & cycles have access, hence the bollards.

We believe that the track to the north east of East Haugh Cottages is used by vehicles. Could you please confirm the reason it has been noted as a footway.

Due to a drafting error this area was incorrectly shown as adopted footway. This location is not adopted nor is it footway. It has now been corrected on our records, and this track is now shown as private carriageway.

Our GIS has been updated to reflect the above information. The online map of adopted and maintained areas on the Council's external website is updated monthly with the same information.
