

## 58900 Short Term Lets Licences

Please note the terms “accepted” and “rejected” have no statutory basis within the licence process and therefore that information is not held.

Applications are checked to ensure they are complete and are accompanied by the required fee. A complete application will be considered as a relevant application in terms of the legislation and will proceed to a determination. Any incomplete applications will be returned as incomplete if the applicant does not provide any missing information within a short period of being requested to. Returning an application as incomplete does not prevent an applicant from submitting a future application which would again be checked to ensure it is relevant.

For relevant applications, the decision (whether the application was granted, refused, withdrawn, etc) is available from our [public register](#). Please reference the field at column K for the decision outcome, and column L for the date that the decision was reached.

Additionally, the Council publishes regular information in the [business bulletin](#) for the Regulatory committee which sets out details of the relevant applications received for an STL licence and outcomes generally for licences determined.

Furthermore, there are reports to the [Regulatory Committee](#) on the subject of STL Licensing which will include similarly requested information and may be illustrative of the number of relevant applications received and determined during the requested timeframe.
