How many households are currently on the gold priority list for council housing?

439.

How many households with gold priority were housed in the last 12 months?

254.

What is the longest time a household has been on gold priority that is currently still waiting?

The applicant who has held gold priority for the longest has held it for 7,657 days. The person with gold priority who has been registered with EdIndex the longest registered in March 2003, and has held gold priority for 304 days.

What is the median time a household has been on gold priority that is currently still waiting? Please also split these by number of bedrooms that would be ideal for each household.

The average number of days those with gold priority have been waiting is 615 days. For 1-bedroom properties, the average waiting time is 531 days. For 2-bedroom properties, the average is 596 days. For 3-bedroom properties it is 846 days and 4 or more bedroom properties is 784 days.

How many vacant wheelchair accessible properties are currently owned by the council? If the information is available, categorise by reason unavailable.

There are currently 27 wheelchair accessible homes empty. Of this total, 22 are currently undertaking remedial works to make them suitable for let, while 5 are ready to let.

What percentage of households with gold priority contain at least 1 wheelchair user?
