

59031 Gilmerton Dykes Street

I am emailing to enquire about a site known as 'Gilmerton Dykes Street, Edinburgh'. We are compiling desktop information and would like to know if you hold any information pertinent to our investigation.

Approximately the western quarter of the site area is formed over an infilled limestone quarry recorded as 'Gilmerton Quarries' on digital archive mapping during the mid part of the 19th century (1854-55). The quarry is recorded disused and infilled before 1908. Building(s) is noted onsite sometime after 1974, most recently recorded as a library to the right of centre and car park left of centre prior to 1992. The library/car park remain after 2015. Most recent O.S mapping post 2019 indicates the structure is no longer present.

More specifically we would like to know if there are any records of historical tanks onsite? If there is an associated cost for this information, please let me know.

We have searched through the records for both current and derelict petroleum stores based on the information that you have provided. Unfortunately, we have been unable to locate any information at Gilmerton Dykes Street, Edinburgh regarding current or derelict petroleum tanks.
