Regarding the contract expiration:

- Scrap Metal - The original contract was not awarded the full extension to 24/11/2025. The new contract, CT1277 was tendered at the beginning of 2025 and awarded with a start date of the 12/05/2025. The contract was awarded to William Waugh (Edinburgh) Limited and goes to their Granton site.
- Dry Mixed Recyclates – Contract CT0753 has been extended until the 28th March 2026 under the procurement rules to allow for the completion of a new tender process. The contract for Dry, Mixed Recyclates has been re-tendered and the award report is due to go to the Finance and Resources Committee on 15th January 2026.
