Request for information regarding placements and spending for older person's domiciliary care services.

Please see the attached, completed template. Please note the following:

Q2 – we have included Care at Home, Mainstream Home Care and Reablement

Q2d – we have counted people starting new services once in a year. If someone moved from Reablement to Mainstream Home Care, within the financial year, this would be counted only once. If they moved over two financial years, they would be counted in both.

Q3a – this is taken from the hours recorded on the commissioned service, rather than any of the cost data and grossed up from the hours per week of the package for the relevant period in the year for which the service was open. These may or may not have been delivered.

Q3b – we do not provide live in care

Q4B - total gross expenditure on direct payments was used due to not having sufficient information to eliminate spend on Care at Home via Direct Payments.

Please note: Due to the distinct legal framework in Scotland, we do not arrange domiciliary care for people over the age of 65 who are 'self-funding' these services.
