

59508 Section 1 of Acquisition of Land (Authorisation Procedure)(Scotland) Act 1947

We would like to (and hereby do) make an Information Request that we be provided with all information collected by you pursuant to your statutory duty under section 1 of Acquisition of Land (Authorisation Procedure)(Scotland) Act 1947 for all Notices/Orders that:

- (1) Have been Served,
- (2) remain extant, (That is to say have been served but are not considered Complied with)
- (3) Have been Complied with (Where there are no works left to be carried out)
- (4) Have been Complied with but have invoices pending in respect of works carried out by or on behalf of your council, during the dates 1st of July 2025 to the 5th January 2026.

The following responses have been provided on the basis that “works” is a reference to the work undertaken in relation to the compulsory purchase process, and not works on a site, ground or land, and that the request covers the period of time between 1 July 2025 and 5 January 2026.

(1) Have been Served – The Council made the City of Edinburgh Council (Roseburn to Union Canal Link - Duff Street Lane Connection) Compulsory Purchase Order 2025 on 11 November 2025 and served notices in respect of that Order on the same date.

(2) Remain Extant - The City of Edinburgh Council (Meadowbank Gas Governor Site) Compulsory Purchase Order 2025.

(3) Have been Complied with - The City of Edinburgh Council (Granton Waterfront, Phase 1) Compulsory Purchaser Order 2023.

The City of Edinburgh Council (West Edinburgh Link: Southern and Central Sections) Compulsory Purchase Order 2023.

(4) Have been Complied with but have invoices pending - Not applicable. Invoices not issued in respect of work carried out for the compulsory purchase process.
