

## 59517 Leith Community Croft

Please provide copies of any lease, licence, management agreement, or other contractual arrangements relating to Leith Community Croft on Leith Links between the City of Edinburgh Council and Earth in Common.

There are two leases in place between the Council and Earth in Common (formerly Leith Community Crops in Pots). One is a ground lease which covers the community croft and the other is a building lease for the old pavilion (both leases are attached). There are no management agreements or other contractual arrangements in place.

Third-party personal information has been redacted from the documents provided in compliance with the Data Protection Act 2018.

Please also provide details of any permissions, consents, or agreements allowing third-party operators or income-generating activities to operate from the site, including but not limited to temporary installations or wellness facilities.

The alienation clauses within both leases set out the position around sub-letting. The Council has not received requests to provide consents to any third-party operations.

In addition, please confirm whether the Council receives any rent, licence fee, concession payment, or revenue share arising from activities operated on the site, and if so, the nature and amount of those payments.

The Council receives a rental payment of £500 per annum for the old pavilion and £1 per annum (if requested) for the community croft.
