The term 'branded' has been defined by the Scottish Government:

'The term 'branded' is used to describe an item of clothing with distinctive features, characteristics or colours which make it unique to a particular school. This may include a logo or badge, braiding on a school blazer, or any particular style of type or colour of clothing that is not available from a range of retailers.'
