All interdepartmental correspondence including emails mentioning Westfield Court, Edinburgh inclusive of the current plans for demolition and all alternatives explored;

All meeting agendas, minutes and closed minutes between Housing, Legal Services, Planning and Building Services discussing the demolition and alternatives for Westfield Court, Edinburgh;

All financial records detailing monies allocated and actually spent on the upkeep (or otherwise) of Westfield Court, Edinburgh and records of meetings detailing discussions and decisions undertaken;

A copy of any risk register created and addressed in relation to the many issues surrounding Westfield Court, Edinburgh;

Confirmation of all properties within Westfield Court, Edinburgh currently owned by City of Edinburgh Council and dates of purchase. This should include values paid for each property.

We consider the request to be manifestly unreasonable because to fully answer the first part of your request alone, we estimate that it would take approximately 91 hours to provide all correspondence in scope of Westfield Court. One staff member from our Legal Services department alone took one hour to locate and retrieve emails for ten days of December for Westfield Court. 11 members of staff would have to look in the same mailbox for the full timescale requested (01/11/25-31/12/25), and two staff members would have to consult a separate mailbox for the requested information. Each individual email would need to be checked to ensure that it is within scope of your request. On an estimate that one staff member would take approximately seven hours to provide all requested correspondence, we estimate that it would take 91 hours to collate the information in scope. Once the information is collated, it then needs to be prepared for release. This includes the removal of all duplicate information and the redaction of all exempt information. This would be in addition to the 91 hours already identified.
