

## 59858 Designated Areas - Consumption of Alcohol Not Permitted

I hope you can help me to establish clarity on the areas within the city where the consumption of alcohol is not permitted.

This document references 'Designated places' highlighted in red within Schedule 1 but the upload appears to be in black and white. Anecdotally I believe this may apply to areas such as the Meadows which are more likely to attract large unofficial public gatherings.

Would you be able to provide this, and possibly consider re-publishing for public viewing?

Please find enclosed a copy of the colour plan. Any area within the red line boundary is deemed to be a 'designated place', including the Meadows.

As the whole of the city is covered by the byelaw, this means that you must stop drinking if you are requested to by a police officer.

We are in the process of reviewing the plan available on our website.
