

59901 Pavement Parking Fines

Under the Transport (Scotland) 2019 Act, drivers who park their vehicles on pavements, double park or block dropped kerbs do so illegally and can be fined £100 by councils. Most local authorities have now begun enforcement under the act.

Can you tell me:

How many fines have been issued by the council between 21 January 2024 to 21 January 2026?

[17,039 Penalty Charge Notices were issued between 21 January 2024 and 21 January 2026 under Transport \(Scotland\) Act 2019 contraventions 100 \(Parked on a pavement\), 101 \(parked adjacent to a dropped kerb crossing point\) and 102 \(parked where no part of the vehicle is within 50 centimetres of the carriageway edge\).](#)

A breakdown of streets on which those fines have been issued; for example '130 fines were issued in Market Street'.

Any occasions where streets have seen repeat pavement parking offenders, by car make and model/colour, for example '13 fines were issued to the driver of a black Audi A5 in Market Street'.
