In each of the past five calendar years, how many noise complaints has your authority received?

In each of the past five calendar years, how many of those noise complaints required formal action to be taken?

In each of the past five calendar years, how many of those noise complaints concerned amplified music?

In each of the past five calendar years, how many of those noise complaints concerned animal noises (barking dogs etc)

In each of the past five calendar years, how many of those noise complaints concerned DIY/construction (drilling/sawing/hammering etc)

In each of the past five calendar years, how many of those noise complaints concerned general household noise (banging of doors/arguments/shouting)?

In each of the past five calendar years, how many of those noise complaints concerned gatherings/parties?

In each of the past five calendar years, how many of those noise complaints have led to noise abatement notices issued by the council?

In each of the past five calendar years, how many of those noise complaints have led to prosecutions by the council?

In each of the past five calendar years, how many of those prosecutions were successfully prosecuted by the council?

Please note that two separate spreadsheets are provided. One representing the information held by our Regulatory Services team, the other representing Housing Support.

Please note that most noise complaints are resolved informally.

Regarding amplified noise complaints, the information provided details only music noise complaints against liquor licensed premises and event noise. It does not specify amplified or otherwise. Other music noise complaints may have been received and recorded as commercial noise, e.g. in instances where music is ancillary to the activities at the premises (such as music playing in a commercial kitchen or unlicensed café).
