

60127 Potholes Repair Costs

Please provide the total amount that the Council spent on fixing potholes, broken down into a table to reflect the following financial years:

2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24, 2024-25, 2025-26 (to date).

We are unable to provide the information requested as it is not separately held by the Council.

Due to the way our costing system works, we cannot split out the Revenue footway and carriageway spend, or separately identify the amount spent specifically on fixing potholes. Although there are repairs to potholes, there are also Capital works carried out on carriageways which happen to include potholes, such as a carriageway renewal. The cost of repairing the potholes within this carriageway renewal is not separately recorded.

Please refer to the table below which provides the Capital and Revenue spend on carriageway and footway repairs from 2021-22 to 2024-25. Pothole repairs are included within these works.
