5.1	<p>At the time of the site visit this section of Warriston Road was fully occupied by parked vehicles. Drivers did not park on the section of double yellow lines opposite the east gate. This allowed vehicles to pass each other using the full width of the carriageway. The presence of the build-out may lead to queuing where vehicles will be unable to pass through the priority give way system. This may result in reversing or manoeuvring collisions.</p>	<p>It is recommended that the length of parking restriction is extended on the north east side of Warriston Road to increase capacity at the give way and to provide a longer section of carriageway to allow vehicle to pass.</p>	<p>Parking Restriction to be extended by 6 meters each side of the pedestrian buildout.</p>
