## Basic Household Starter Packs for Refugee Resettlement

For the purposes of this request, a “basic household starter pack” refers to the standard furniture, mattresses and household appliances provided to refugees when moving from temporary accommodation into permanent accommodation in Edinburgh. This includes arrangements where provision is delivered through partner organisations, such as Fresh Start.

Unless stated otherwise, I would be grateful if the information could cover the financial years 2022/23, 2023/24 and 2024/25 (to date).

I would kindly request the following information:

Confirmation of whether basic household starter packs are provided directly by the Council or through partner organisations.

Where partner organisations are involved (including Fresh Start), the nature of the arrangement (for example, grant funding or service agreement).

The total annual expenditure by the Council on basic household starter packs for each of the years listed above.

While there may be small variations between households, a Refugee New Home Starter Pack would typically include:

- bed frames, mattresses and bedding appropriate to size and ages of the household
- sofa(s) and chairs appropriate to size of family, coffee table
- bedroom wardrobes
- dining table and chairs appropriate to size of family
- white goods, e.g. washing machines, cookers, fridge, freezers, microwave
- floor coverings (carpet/vinyl as appropriate)
- curtains/blinds
- crockery, cutlery, pots and pans
- iron, ironing board, vacuum cleaner

For each year, the number of households supported through the provision of basic household starter packs, or the closest equivalent figure held.

2022/23:	25 households
2023/24:	16 households
2024/25:	37 households
2025/26:	37 households

For the avoidance of doubt, the information supplied is in relation to households resettled in Edinburgh under UK Government resettlement schemes, e.g. the United Kingdom Refugee Scheme (UKRS), Afghan Resettlement Programme (ARP), etc.
